Each Year, The Casey Tibbs Foundation holds a Tribute Dinner to honor deserving individuals, families, and animal athletes, who have been active in the world of rodeo and ranching in South Dakota. We DO NOT consider this an induction into the Casey Tibbs South Dakota Rodeo Center. Casey Tibbs did not wish the Casey Tibbs South Dakota Rodeo Center would become a "Hall of Fame" that required induction; therefore, the Tribute Dinner was created. Rather than requiring an induction into the Casey Tibbs SD Rodeo Center, we display a variety of those who have contributed to and/or excelled in the sport of rodeo in our state, and annually pay tribute to six deserving people in effort to promote and preserve rodeo in South Dakota. In turn, we do hope that those who are honored throughout the years take pride in being lasting part of the Rodeo Center.

The Casey Tibbs Foundation has assembled a committee made of individuals from across South Dakota. The Casey Tibbs Board of Directors divided the state into six regions, granting each region two Tribute Dinner Nomination Committee spots. Each year, the selected committee meets in July* to review all nominations submitted to The Casey Tibbs Foundation, and chooses two nominations in each category. The two nominations from each category are then recommended to the Casey Tibbs Foundation Board of Directors, who decide, via vote, who will be honored at that year's Casey Tibbs Foundation Tribute Dinner.

The six categories for nomination are:

Rodeo Cowgirl Great Rodeo Cowboy Great Past Rodeo Great
Rodeo Promoter Ranch/Cowboy Family Rodeo Animal Athlete
